



Modular rug made by joining round, square and rectangular elements.

These elements are composed by an upper layer in Brio fabric – obtained from production cuttings that would otherwise remain unused – and by a lower layer in synthetic felt – made of polyester fibers derived from the recycling of PET bottles from waste sorting, that will be 100% recyclable again – coupled and sewn together with Punto Pettine stitching.

The elements are then joined to form the rug surface.

The floor can be seen through the gaps between the elements.

The rug is made by joining production offcuts that would otherwise remain unused; for this reason, it is possible to choose only the main shade or to opt for a multicolour version that will be produced with what is available at the time of order.
